This year marks the sixth Science Meets Parliament Program since its inauguration in 2018. Since then, the program has expanded to the provinces, with the first-ever SMP-BC in April 2024 and expanded to SMP-Ontario in 2025. This program has become the largest platform that connects researchers to Parliamentarians where more than 250 researchers have met with more than 250 parliamentarians in one on one meetings. SMP is a high-impact opportunity for researchers in Canada to strengthen their relationship with parliamentarians, learn about policymaking and develop skills and experience in science policy.

The objective of this initiative is to strengthen the connections between Canada's scientific and political communities, enable a two-way dialogue, and promote mutual understanding. This initiative aims to help scientists become familiar with policy making at the political level, and for parliamentarians to explore using scientific evidence in policy making. The program is NOT an advocacy exercise for science or for the scientific community.
