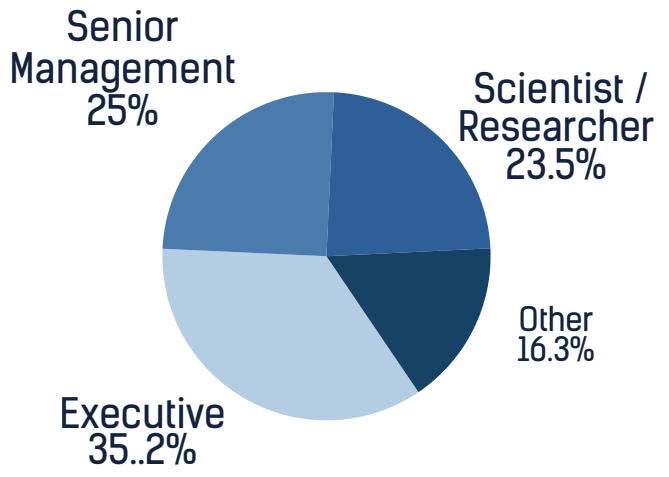

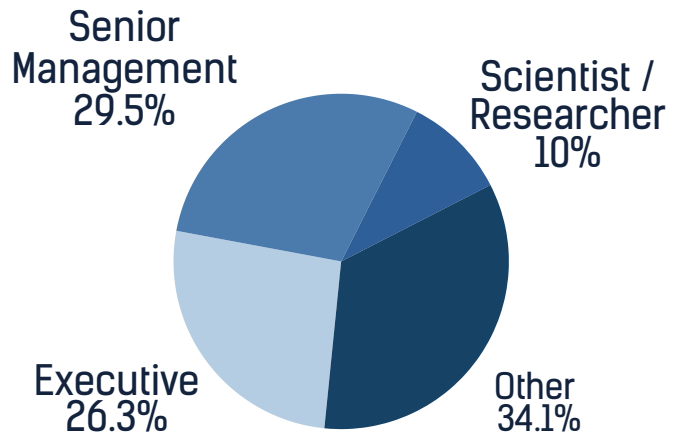

Distribution by Position

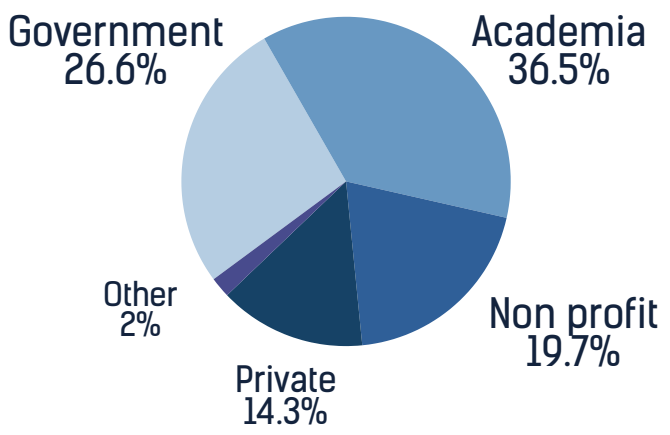

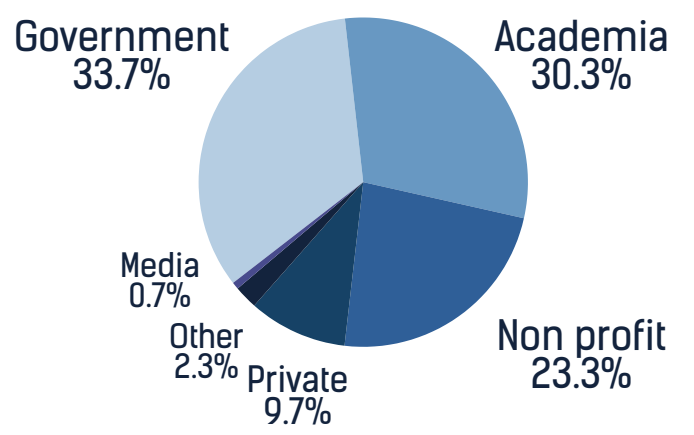
Distribution by Position
